



## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

### **NORTH SOMERSET COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - Section 14 Notice of Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2020 Whitehouse Lane, Wraxall North Somerset Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles Order 2020 Date coming Into Force: 14th April 2020**

**Notice** is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

**Exemptions** are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

**This order** is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by National Grid Company to construct a Bell-mouth access. This will become operative on the 14th April 2020 for a maximum period of eighteen months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be of 18 days in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

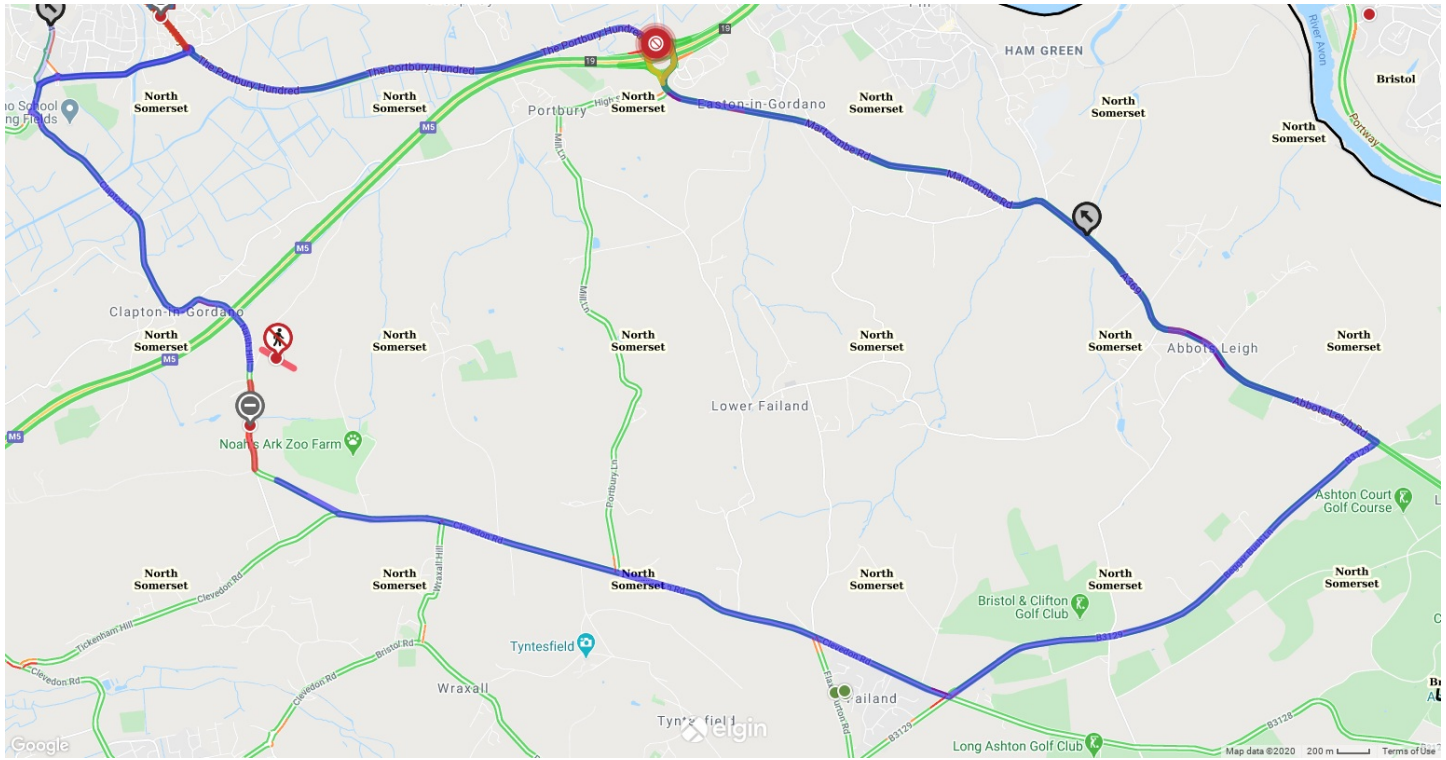
