Final Notice of Temporary Traffic Regulation Order
Moor Lane, Clapton Lane, Clapton-in-Gordano, Bristol (Portishead) North Somerset
Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles Order 2026
Date coming Into Force: 22nd January 2026

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access, works vehicles and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Openreach for pole testing. This order will become operative on the 22nd January 2026 for a maximum period of eighteen months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be of 2 days in duration between 09:30 and 15:30. The commencement dates of the phase closures are approximate and subject to the progression of the works. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Schedule (in phases) -

Moor Lane - 10m from junction with Clapton Lane for approx. 35m. Access will be maintained for residents.

Clapton Lane - from outside Sperrings Farm to junction with Maysfield Close.
